Here are a few ideas for some home learning activities. These are *only* suggestions for starting points. Please feel free to be as creative as you like.

- Ask an older person (parents, grandparents, neighbours...) about the toys they liked to play with when they were children. Which toy was their favourite and why? You could write about what they say, draw a picture, or record an interview!
 - Keep a 'play diary' for a week - which toys did you play with each day and for how long?
- Find different ways to group and sort your toys - how many ways can you come up with? Take photos or draw pictures to record your ideas.
 - Get creative! Try designing and making your own toy... (there are lots of inspiring ideas online).
 - Make a passport for one of your toys.
- Find out about some toys and games children like to play in different parts of the world.
 - Write a story featuring one or more of your toys.
