

# Spelling Strategies

Use these spelling strategies to help you to remember your spellings.

<p><b>Rainbow Words</b></p> <p>First write your spelling words in pencil. Trace over the words 5 times using a different coloured crayon each time.</p>	<p><b>Pyramid Writing</b></p> <p>Pyramid write your spelling words. Try to write them neatly!</p> <p>Example:     s               so              som             some</p>	<p><b>ABC Order</b></p> <p>Write out your spelling words in alphabetical order.</p>
<p><b>Fancy Letters</b></p> <p>Write out each of your spelling words using fancy writing. Your letters could be curly or dotty.</p>	<p><b>Backwards Words</b></p> <p>Write out your spelling words forwards and then backwards.</p> <p>Example: home    emoh</p>	<p><b>Across and Down</b></p> <p>Write each word across and down, sharing the same first letter.</p> <p>Example:   when               h              e              n</p>
<p><b>Bubble Words</b></p> <p>Write your spelling words in bubble letters. After you have written them you can colour them in with crayons.</p>	<p><b>Headlines</b></p> <p>Cut letters out of newspapers and magazines to spell out your words. Stick them down to a piece of paper.</p>	<p><b>Curly Words</b></p> <p>Firstly, write your spelling words out in normal letters. Then write them again in curly letters!</p>
<p><b>Tell a Story</b></p> <p>Write a story using all of your spelling words. Make sure you underline your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>Three Times</b></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words three times using a different coloured crayon or pen each time.</p>	<p><b>Acrostic Poem</b></p> <p>Choose one of your spelling words. Write an acrostic poem using that word. Illustrate your poem.</p> <p>Example: sun           Summer is here           Under the rays           New flowers grow</p>
<p><b>Blue Vowels</b></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words. Trace the vowels in your words with a blue coloured pencil.</p> <p>Vowels:   a   e   i   o   u</p>	<p><b>Spelling Shapes</b></p> <p>Count your spelling words. Draw one shape for each word. Now write a spelling word in each of the shapes.</p> <p>Example:   when   four   nice</p>	<p><b>Upper and Lower</b></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words two times. First, write each word in upper case letters. Then write each word in lower case letters.</p>
<p><b>3D Words</b></p> <p>Make your spelling words out of playdough or clay.</p>	<p><b>Connect the Dots</b></p> <p>Write your spelling words using dots. Connect the dots you've drawn by tracing over them with a coloured pencil.</p>	<p><b>Spelling Flowers</b></p> <p>Draw a big flower. Write each of your spelling words on one of the petals.</p>
<p><b>Silly Sentences</b></p> <p>Write silly sentences with a spelling word in each sentence. Underline your spelling words.</p> <p>Example: My cat <u>wears</u> a yellow hat when she goes dancing.</p>	<p><b>Air Write</b></p> <p>Write your spelling words in the air with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write. You could also ask someone to air write while you read the word!</p>	<p><b>Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check</b></p> <p>Look at your word then say it. Cover your word then write it and then check it! Did you spell it correctly?</p>
