Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents/Carers

This week our Elephants have begun their adventure with us, having spent a whole week in school. We are incredibly impressed with how well our youngest children have settled into school and learnt their new routines. Reception Phonics Information Session

On Monday 27th September 2:45pm - 3:15pm, Mr Lees-Smith will hold an information session on how we teach phonics at St John's. Phonics forms the basis for the children's reading, writing and spelling, so we are very keen to share what we do; so that you can support the children in the same way at home. This session will be held in our school hall.

Their password will not be affected and remain the same.


