Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents/Carers.

We certainly feel as if we have slipped into Autumn this week with the weather being a little cooler and wetter. When we return from half term, please ensure that your child brings a coat to school everyday as the children will go out to play even if it is slightly raining.

As you are aware from previous communication, we have seen a number of positive covid cases at St John's. I have been in frequent contact with both public health and the local authority and am assured that all the control measures we have put in place reduce the risks of transmission as much as we can. We will be continuing our covid contingency measures after half term. Thank you for your ongoing support on this matter. Please be reminded that if your child has symptoms we ask that you keep them at home and aet a PCR test.

Teachers have thoroughly enjoyed speaking to parents this week during parent consultation evenings. If you didn't get the chance to book, please contact the school office and they can arrange a telephone appointment for you and the class teacher.

With Remembrance Day coming up quickly after half term, the Keep Military Museum has been in contact with us and asked that we help them with a display they are creating in Dorchester. To commemorate those lost at war, the museum will be hanging poppy covered netting over their building which will be seen across the town. This week some children have been making poppies out of red felt. These have been posted to the museum where they will be waterproofed and attached to the netting. St John's First School will be publicly acknowledged on a sign by the entrance of the museum near the display. If you have an opportunity to visit in November, please take photos and share them with us in school.

'I have shown wisdom by helping my brother decide things.'


'I have shown wisdom in school by being a role model because I am in the highest year group.'
