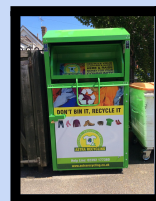




The Friends of St John's are busy organising a picnic event to celebrate the end of term on Friday 7th July, 4.30pm-6.30pm. More information to follow.
