### Communication and Language:

I will learn to...

- Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- To understand a question or instruction that has two parts
- Learn new vocabulary and use it through the day.
- Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.
- Develop social phrases.
- Engage in story times; talking about stories to build familiarity

### Literacy: I will learn to...

- To hear initial sounds in words & orally recognise words with the same initial sound.
- To recognise and write some or all of their name
- Read individual letters and some letter groups by saying the sounds
- Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter-sound correspondences.
- Read a few common exception words matched to the school's phonic programme.

### Maths:

I will learn to...

- Count objects, actions and sounds.
- Subitise.
- Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value
- Understand the 'one more than/one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers.
- To copy, continue and create simple repeating patterns (AB patterns using)
- To use language to describe when events happen (day, night, morning, afternoon, before, after, today, tomorrow).

### Phonics:

We have moved onto Phase 3. We will be learning an average of 4 new phonemes per week and learning to write the corresponding grapheme. We will also be learning new Common Exception Words. Please practise new phonemes and words at home as per homework provided.

### Expressive Arts and Design:

I will learn to...

- Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.
- Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings
- To join in with singing songs and nursery rhymes, beginning to participate more readily.
- To begin to use role play resources such as drapes, dressing up clothes and props to play imaginatively with their friends.
