There was great excitement in Dolphins class today when they received a reply from Sir David Attenborough!



A reminder that our doors open at **8:45am** each day. The school gate will be open before this time to allow families to wait in the playground rather than on the pavement. The doors will remain closed until **8:45am**, even though the gate is open before this time. It is important that you stay with your child until they have entered their door as there is no supervision from staff on the playground. All children should be in their classroom by **8:55am** as this is when the register is taken. We appreciate your support with this.

### **Clothes Recycling**

We have received £30 for the school from your donations between October and December!

Thank you for putting your unwanted clothes and shoes in the Astra recycling bank at the front of the school. Clothes can take up to 40 years to decompose and shoes up to 1000 years to break down, but 95% of these can be recycled! Astra recycling provides a service and pays 40p per kilo for what is collected! The bank is emptied every 2 weeks. The textiles collected are either sent to Eastern Europe to be used again or converted into insulation materials and industrial cleaning wipes, so less than 1% of what we collect ends up in the ground. This is a great way to fundraise for the school as well as promote the importance of recycling.

They accept the following wearable items:

- All men's, ladies' and children's clothing including school uniform
- Paired Shoes
- Handbags, bags, ties and belts
- Bed clothes, towels, soft toys

Astra Recycling cannot accept or pay for the following items:

- Duvets both synthetic and feathered
- Pillows & cushions
- Carpets & Rugs
- Soiled or wet clothing
- Workwear
- Shredded or mutilated textile material
- Textile offcuts, yarns or threaded material

### **Lost Property**


