Welcome to Year 1 with Mrs Aryal.
Our topic is **Welcome to Wimborne** and we will be learning:

Phonics home learning will be set on Google Classroom weekly. Maths home learning will be set on Google Classroom fortnightly.
Thank you for reading daily with your child.

English

Key texts: Here We Are, The Three Little Pigs, Mr Wolf's Pancakes.

We will:

- Develop confident formation of lowercase and uppercase letters and numbers.
- Understand the elements of simple sentences, including capital letters and full stops.
- Identify characteristics of fairy tales and traditional tales, finding similarities and differences between them.
- Plan and make plays from stories, using clear voices and props.

Phonics

We will:

- Revise previously taught sounds and common exception words.
- Add suffixes (-s, -es, -ing, -ed, -er, -est) and the prefix un-.
- Name the letters of the alphabet in order.

Science

We will:

- Investigate using our senses of sight, touch, smell, taste and hearing and know which body part is associated with each sense.
- Make observations, predictions and ask questions.

Mathematics

We will be using 'White Rose' as a resource to develop our depth of understanding, fluency and confidence in mathematics.

We will:

- Sort, count objects from a larger group and count on from any number.
- Count and order numbers to 10 accurately, forwards and backwards.
- Read and write numbers to 10 in numerals and words.
- Compare objects, using terms 'equal to', 'more than', 'less than'.
- Explore number bonds to 10.
- Order objects and numbers using a number line.

Physical Education

We will develop our Fundamental Skills to move confidently and safely in a variety of ways, Please bring **P.E. kits** at the start of the week for us to get changed on **Thursdays** and please wear **Forest School** clothes on **Mondays**.

PSHE

We will:

- Know the class and school expectations and their importance.
- Elect and vote for Worship Team and School Council.
- Learn more about what it means to be 'HeartSmart'.
- Explore emotions, feelings, values, healthy minds and healthy and hygienic bodies.

Computing

We will:

- Understand what is meant by technology.
- Discuss examples of technology both in and out of school.
- Learn to use Chrome Books, including logging in, using the trackpad and simple features.

Religious Education

We will be developing our understanding of what religious stories teach us, focusing on the Christian story of Creation.
Our Christian value for this half term is **Thankfulness**.

History

We will discuss changes over time and the past, with a focus on Tim Berners-Lee (the founder of the World Wide Web) as a well-known person who lived and worked in our local area.

Geography

We will look at the globe and maps to find England and Wimborne. We will discuss the features of a town and draw our own maps.

Art

Focus artist: Kandinsky

We will learn how to mix primary colours. We will use a range of media, materials and brushes.

Music

We will identify the mood of music, listen to and learn songs. We will begin to compose and perform and create simple notations to represent sounds.
