

English

This term we will continue the Unlocking Letters and Sounds Phonics programme which will support reading and spelling. We will also be reading *The Day the Crayons Quit* by Drew Daywalt. The children will look at the features of letters and then write their own. There will also be an opportunity to write their own story about the crayons. The children will learn about different types of sentences such as statements, commands and questions. The children will also be reading poems about colour such as *What is Pink?* by Christina Rossetti. They will then plan and write their own poems.

Please continue to read regularly with your child. It really helps them to enjoy books and read with confidence. Your child will have spelling home learning every Friday. This will be set on Google Classroom.

Mathematics

In Maths this term, the children will develop their understanding of numbers to 100. They will learn to read, write, represent, partition, compare and order numbers, as well as count in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will also explore addition and subtraction using practical resources and mental strategies, applying their knowledge to solve problems and explain their mathematical thinking.



Religious Education

Our value for this half term is Wisdom. We will focus on what we can learn from the story of Creation, such as the responsibility placed on humans to look after themselves and the world, and how God helps us to do this. We will have opportunity to share our thanks for God's creation.

Science

The children will explore micro-habitats this half term and identify plants and animals within them. Through observation, children will understand things are suited to the habitats they live in. They will ask questions about the world around us and recognise that they can find answers in different ways, making predictions and using simple equipment.

Year 2

Autumn Term 1

We Are Colourful



Geography - London

The children will use simple compass directions (north, south, east, and west) and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map. They will use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features.

Music

The children will develop their awareness of dynamics and identify changes in these. They will sing with an awareness of pitch, dynamics and tempo and develop playing untuned percussion.

Computing

This half term the children will use a digital device to take a photograph and then use tools to change it. They will also develop their online safety by investigating digital privacy and reflecting on how people may look and act differently online.

Art

The children will be building on their knowledge of mixing primary and secondary colours by exploring how to make colours darker and lighter to create new shades, tints and hues. They will be using their sketchbooks to experiment with drawing and painting. There will be the opportunity to look at a range of famous art work and find similarities and differences.

PSHE - Get HeartSmart

The children will learn what it is to be HeartSmart and how we can 'Power ON' to love ourselves and others well.

Physical Education

PE will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. The children will develop their fundamental ball skills such as throwing and catching, rolling, hitting a target, dribbling with both hands and feet and kicking a ball. They will have the opportunity to work independently, in pairs and small groups. They will also develop the skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping.
